Scott graduated in 1985 from East Carolina University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, and in 1988, he received his MBA, also from ECU. He began a retail career with Brody Brothers Dry Goods, Inc. in Greenville, NC, a North Carolina based chain of upscale clothing stores. As Vice President of Operations, Scott developed and coordinated responsibilities for Human Resources, Distribution, Retail Store Operations, Marketing, New Facility Planning/Construction, Purchasing, and Plant/Facility Operations. The company was sold in 1998 to a major U.S. retailer.

In 1998, Scott formed 4 C's Group, Inc., a consulting, management and leadership organization that provides services in three primary areas; corporate and association leadership development; meetings, conventions and events management; and as a provider of logo apparel for corporate and association clients. Since 1998 Scott has traveled extensively throughout the US providing event management, keynote addresses and leadership seminars.

A former Key Club member and distinguished Lt. Governor, Scott became a Kiwanis member in 1987, joining the University City Kiwanis Club in Greenville, NC. As a Kiwanis member, he has served as Distinguished Club President, Key Club District Financial Advisor, Circle K District Administrator, Key Club District Administrator, Kiwanis District Sponsored Youth Administrator, and Kiwanis Advisor to his local Key Club. He was presented the Key of Honor at the 1997 International Convention in Nashville, Tennessee. The Key of Honor is the highest award that can be presented to anyone involved in the Key Club program, and a maximum of 2 awards are presented each year at the annual Key Club International Convention. In 2005 he was charter President of the Key2kiwanis club, the 5<sup>th</sup> internet based Kiwanis club ever started.
